

CNA102 – Introduction to Appraisal Standards

Text: 2018 – 2019 eUSPAP

This is a self-study of the eUSPAP (electronic USPAP) for 2018-2019 Edition of the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice. Students are expected to navigate through the USPAP, Advisory Opinions (AO), and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) and then complete 3 'open-book' quizzes, to be approved for the final exam.

When registered for the course, students receive, by email:

1. eUSPAP Pdf
2. 2018-2019 USPAP Declaration Pdf
3. 2018-2019 USPAP quizzes.

The quizzes is to be completed, and emailed to CNAREA for marking. Upon successful completion of the quizzes, the student will be approved to challenge the final test.

Successful completion of the course will provide the student with 16 hours of CE Credits.

This is a mandatory course for all Candidate members and must be completed within 4 months of joining CNAREA.
